# 16-0141 Setting of the Maxmimum Millage Preliminary Rate

Micah Maxwell, Town Manager, stated that staff felt a millage increase was not necessary.

Micah Badana, Management Analyst II, discussed the changes in Revenues and Estimated expenditures. The Total Ad Valorem Taxable increase is 5.79%.
