

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BELLEAIR, FLORIDA,
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE PROPOSED
CHARTER AMENDMENT DURING THE REGULAR
MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 15, 2022.**

WHEREAS, there was a regular municipal election scheduled for March 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission desired to submit a proposed charter amendment for consideration by the Town's qualified electors; that question is as follows:

**AMENDING REQUIREMENTS TO ABOLISH MUNICIPAL
DEPARTMENTS AND SPECIFYING PROCESS
TO ABOLISH POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Shall the Town amend Section 2.07 (f) of the Charter to require a unanimous vote to abolish a municipal department provided for in the charter, as otherwise required by statute, and require abolition of the police department only by the unanimous adoption of an ordinance, the passage of which would be subject to referendum per Section 8.01(b) of the Town's Charter?

WHEREAS, the Town Commission of the Town of Belleair is charged with the duty of declaring the results of the election; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND DECLARED that the proposed Charter amendment was approved by a majority of the electors voting on such amendment. The approved amendment shall be incorporated into the Charter and thereafter, the Town Clerk shall file the revised Charter with the Florida Secretary of State.
