

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BELLEAIR, FLORIDA, DECLARING TOM KUREY AND TOM SHELLY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE TOWN OF BELLEAIR FOR THE TERM BEGINNING MARCH 15 2022.

WHEREAS, Section 2.01(c) of the Charter of the Town of Belleair, Florida provides that “The Commission shall by resolution order an election to be held on a Tuesday in March of each year in which the term of the Mayor or Commissioner expires”; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.01(c) further provides that the elected officials shall hold office for a period of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission of the Town of Belleair, Florida, by Resolution No. 2021-39 entitled “**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BELLEAIR, FLORIDA, CALLING FOR A REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND SETTING DATE FOR SAID ELECTION**” called for a regular election to be held on March 15, 2022 for the purpose of electing two (2) Commissioners to fill the expiring terms of Commissioner Tom Kurey and Commissioner Tom Shelly; and

WHEREAS, the only candidates to file for the aforesaid offices by the final filing date were Tom Kurey and Tom Shelly; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 101.151(7), Florida Statutes, stated that “the names of unopposed candidates shall not appear on the general election ballot. Each unopposed candidate shall be deemed to have voted for himself”; and

WHEREAS, no write-in candidates qualified for the aforesaid offices in accordance with the requirement of the Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF BELLEAIR, FLORIDA THAT:

Tom Kurey and Tom Shelly are deemed to have voted for themselves and are hereby declared to be elected to the office of Commissioner for the term beginning April 5, 2022.
