

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-16**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BELLEAIR, FLORIDA,  
AUTHORIZING DESIGNATED SIGNERS FOR ACCOUNTS HELD  
WITH FINANCIAL OR OTHER INSTITUTIONS FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING TOWN BUSINESS; PROVIDING  
FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND  
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, from time to time, the Town Commission wishes to amend the list of persons as designated signers on behalf of the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 2024-29 is hereby rescinded;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF BELLEAIR, FLORIDA**, that:

**Section 1.** Any financial or other institution is hereby directed to honor, pay and charge to the accounts of the Town, without inquiry as to the circumstances of the issuance or application of the proceeds of, checks, drafts, items or other written orders on any of the Town's accounts with the entity, whether or not payable to, endorsed or negotiated by or for the credit of any person signing the same or any other person of the Town, when signed by two (2) of the following persons of the Town.

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**Section 2.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect or any other section or part of this Resolution.

**Section 4.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
