Dear Ms. Hoglund:

Pinellas County has proposed the construction of a sidewalk on the northside of Mehlenbacher Road, from Indian Rocks Road to the Pinellas Trail. Adjacent to your residence, the intersection of Pineland Avenue and Mehlenbacher Road will be realigned to improve the sight distance. The planned improvements are within the existing publicly owned right-of-way.

During a recent site visit with your contractor and JP Murphy from the Town of Belleair, the County Project Manager, John A. Carpenter, explained the proposed realignment. The proposed realignment closes the southern driveway. The existing northern driveway on your property will remain open.

Attached is a draft copy of the proposed intersection alignment and the garage plan that was submitted by the engineer that designed the garage layout. The construction of the proposed sidewalk improvements is estimated to begin in late November to early December of 2021.
