Deputy Mayor Shelly requested quick update on recreation events.

Kelly Flowers-Bonefas -Recreation Manager-announced upcoming events, Centennial Concert, BCF Rumble, Springfest and Arbor Day; summer camp registration starting.

Deputy Mayor Shelly requested update from SWFWMD representative in attendance.

Amber Smith-Southwest Florida Water Management District, Government Affairs-thanked town staff for meeting; spoke on past hurricane season and ongoing support; seeing how to support ensuring waterways are clear. Deputy Mayor Shelly commented on water that comes from outside of town; Ms. Smith spoke on rain in

watershed that flows to all areas; can assist in communication with residents.
